Environmental Materials With the demand growing for coal fly ash products, additional ash sources have been sought and secured to increase production and an additional silo was purchased (and hauled in from Florida). Other supporting equipment (augers, dust control, etc.) is also being added and final changes being made to the pole barn to make the working environment more comfortable and safe. EM is hopeful the demand will continue far past the pay off of this large initial investment in land/building lease and equipment purchases for this bagging operation.

Quarry Services (QS) Sugar Beet Loading Campaign The sudden snow and frigid temperature change causes the front-end loader workers some discomfort, yet the campaign is going well. Each site has a warming "hut" and workers are encouraged to dress properly for the cold weather. Trailer Wash Out Procedure

The average trailer takes 1 ½ to 2 hours to wash out and dry in the summer and using a blower in the winter as long as 8 hours. Yet it is critical that trailers be thoroughly cleaned when changing from one product to another....before the new load. The wash out procedure in WT's Safety Manual has been updated/ strengthened and all drivers have received training — to understand the vital importance of this task and exactly how to complete it successfully.
